

EMERSON CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

Emerson City Council met on Monday, December 5th, 2011, at Emerson City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Chuck Moyers at 6:00 pm.

Council members present: Robert Delisi, Don Lee, Paul Faxon, Teresa Poulson, Denny Proctor

A motion was made by Council member Delisi, seconded by Lee to approve the agenda with revisions. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Council member Lee, seconded by Poulson to approve the November 7th minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Council member Poulson, seconded by Lee to approve the November 16th minutes. All ayes. Motion carried.

No treasurer's report at this time.

A motion was made by Council member Lee, seconded by Delisi to approve the Accounts Payables. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Council member Proctor, seconded by Lee to approve the Financial Reports. All ayes. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Council member Delisi, seconded by Council member Poulson to allow the Fire Department to proceed in the search for FREE used/refurbished/upgraded Fire Department vehicles for purchase. All ayes with the exception of Council member Faxon who abstained. Motion carried. Transportation costs will be responsibility of the Fire Department.

A second estimate will be acquired for the levee recertification from TB Squared.

Morton and Manchester street condition since water leakage will remain as is until spring. The City awaits a bid.

A motion was made by Council member Faxon, seconded by Lee to supply sand to the school. All ayes. Motion carried.

Judy Magers and Paul Faxon were sworn in as Council members for the next year.

Chuck Moyers was sworn in as Mayor for the next two years.

Iowa West will be checked into for siren monies.

The Mayor will discuss the apartment situation with the lawyer.

The curb stop was located two feet underground at 700 Wilson.

Paul Faxon reported for the Fire Department. Three calls took place last month for medical.

No Library Report.

The mayor discussed the snow removal plans with the town man. The water tower has been cleaned. Low water pressure was reported for some of the Edwards Street residents. This could be caused by household faucet screens not being cleared. Rock was requested to be filled in down at the dump for muddy holes and at the residence of 602 Wilson.

A motion was made by Council member Faxon, seconded by Council member Delisi to remove the water bill penalty at 708 Manchester due to illness. All ayes. Motion carried.

The January Council meeting has been changed to the 9th.

A letter was received from a Des Moines student requesting information on Emerson. Judy Magers will respond.

A motion was made by Council member Faxon, seconded by Delisi to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried.
